MAGIC WEAPON away well, with the early pace closest to the inside, showed the way through the turn while continuing along the rail, slowly edged out final furlong, driving. IDE BOOGIE vied early off the inside, proved no match in the late going. BABA BLUE off a bit slow, sluggish early, advanced while along the inside turn, failed to sustain that effort in the late going. FLYING GAL within striking distance three wide for a half, came up empty when the real running started at the head of the lane. MY MEOW turned in a dull effort inside. QUITE SPENDER steady fade off rail, far back at the finish.
