FORTY DOLLS broke with the field, asked just enough to maintain inside position along the rail, vied into the stretch, edged clear final furlong. ROUXBEE slight lead early while off the inside, vied between foes late in the turn and into the stretch, could not match strides with the winner the final furlong, second best. GLORIOUS QUEST last away, trailed early, circled rivals when beginning to move late in the turn, coming late well out in the strip. SAY SOMETHIN FUNNY forwardly placed early off the rail, ranged up to lodge a bid three wide late in the turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. MERRY MARY went evenly in lacking a late bid. GO MISS BAG failed to respond from well back. MIDNIGHT JUDGE backed up through the stretch. CHOCOLATE GAL was finished early.
