WHAT A TRIBUTE broke on top, set the pace, well clear second turn, maintained a comfortable advantage through the lane under steady urging. DOUBLE STEAL settled off the pace, saved ground second turn, advanced rail, proved determined for the place. PRINCE OF FIRE forwardly placed, lacked a winning kick in the drive, outfinished for the place. DUCK GUMBO went evenly throughout while also lacking a closing punch. HUNTER VISION void of speed in trailing much of the way, roused three wide into the lane, lacked a serious rally as well. IMA SMASH OAK prompted the pace off the inside, gave way. TIGER TAYLOR outrun while wide.
