Footnotes

GLASS MACHINE narrowly set the pace, edged away in the stretch under steady handling. MONEY MAC pressured the winner outside, could do little with that foe in the drive, proved game for the place. AVIE'S LUCKY WAY broke in, straightened then moved up the inside, slight steady far turn, continued to race inside, outfinished for the place. TWO JAYS SECRET vied three wide, did not have enough in the drive. PANCHO'S SILVER moved up closer, steadied repeatedly in tight early in the turn, fell back and went evenly through the stretch. CLOVER BEND pushed out at the start, made little impact. FOUR SONS MONEY void of early foot, never menaced. WHY NOT SO broke to the outside, vied four wide through the turn, gave way in the drive. SWINGING STAR was finished early.
