PATTER FLATTER pressed the leader, moved up challenge while between foes second turn, showed the way into the lane, shook clear when straightened for home, enough left to hold the runner up safe late. MONEIGH lacked speed, behind the leaders second turn, split foes, roused, getting to the winner late. BONNIES JUDGE four wide in the first turn, advanced, vied four wide through the second bend, weakened in the drive, caught for place. SERA'S TUNNEL broke alertly, set the pace inside, vied closest to the rail second turn, weakened in the drive. ATSILA within striking distance, challenged three wide and between rivals in the second turn, had little left for the drive. ALLURE last away, trailed throughout.
