BEE TREE lacked speed, angled out, roused five wide exiting the final turn, finished with good late energy to be in time. ILE ST. LOUISVILLE settled in the second flight, encountered traffic second turn, brief wait a quarter out, split foes, bit tight late, willingly to earn the place. STONE SKIPPER outrun early off the inside, came four wide into the lane, bid inside the furlong marker, outkicked for the place. LUCKY A. C. in the second group, advanced and lodged a four wide bid between foes in the second turn, failed to sustain that bid in the drive. PATSY'S PROM DATE off slowly, raced back early, ranged up with a bold move to challenge in the second turn, clear into the stretch, faltered when confronted late. DEACON BOB raced in the second flight along the inside, traffic second turn, shuffled back a bit, moved out, angled back to the inside for the drive, finished up evenly. TWOWAY HIGHWAY void of speed, improved position a bit in the drive while never a serious threat. TUNNELA WAY vied up front along the inside, gave way in the second turn. MARKSVILLE vied up front three wide, also backed up in the drive. MY LION WAYS was finished early, far back, distanced. DIAMOND LAKE HONEY vied up front while between foes, stopped badly and was distanced.
