DEPUTY DEHERE outrun in the early going, saved some ground through the turn, rallied up the rail, bid midstretch, well clear. EURO SIERRA broke alertly, alternated up front off the inside, no match for the winner late, gained the nod for the place. FINE TROUBLEMAKER dueled up front inside the runner up but off the inside, allowed the winner the inside nearing the furlong marker, also had little for that rival late, missed the nod for the place. SLEW SALUTE in the second flight closest to the inside, lacked a closing kick in the drive. MR. ETBAUER also in the second group, four wide into the turn, got out a bit to be five wide late in the bend, briskly roused right handed, went evenly to the wire. GIVEN TRAPP failed to make an impact. EDDIE RICO last to leave, lacked a rally. TRUKARMA failed to threaten while saving ground.
