SKIPPING TOWN away in good order, raced in the second group while saving ground, challenged up the rail midstretch, quickly clear under steady handling. DIRT ROAD CAT set or forced the pace along the inside for three furlongs, drifted off the in rail stretch which allowed the winner a path inside, no match for that one, held the place. SPIRIT'S ANGEL dueled up front while off the inside, continued to vie past the furlong marker, also proved no match for the winner late, outfinished for the place. BOX WINE BETTY evenly paced behind the leaders, did not have enough in the late going for the place. MORNING RIDGE lacked a closing kick while racing just off the inside. DO THE TIGER remained near the back and was never dangerous. BOMBARDA five wide late in the turn, tired in the drive. EL YEAH slow early, continued to trail throughout.
