Footnotes

GITTIUPGO forwardly placed, moved up to challenge and vie three wide through the turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, edged away late under steady handling. SONG PRODUCTION broke on top, narrowly set the pace while closest to the inside of the first flight, continued to vie into the lane, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late, remained well clear for the place. MISS DYLAN with the pace while off the inside, between the top two into the stretch, weakened, saved the show. TAYLORS SISTER evenly paced throughout while along the inside. COUNT ON LYNN within striking distance early, continued in the second flight while between foes in the turn, came up empty when asked for a response in the drive. SILVER MITTEN last away, never a threat while trailing most of the way. KILLISTOS CLASSIC four wide through the turn, tired.
