Footnotes

CHARLES EDWIN did not break with the field, moved inside then through some traffic in the turn, roused for the drive, carried out slightly by the runner up inside the furlong marker, finished strongly to be clear at the end. THUNDERPANTS never far back while toward the inside, angled out three wide for the drive, drifted a bit just inside the furlong grounds, could not match strides with the winner late, up for the place. ZAVATA FLASH broke well, vied off the inside, garnered a larger advantage past the furlong pole, could not contain the top two. WESTERN PINE forward early, vied through the turn closest to the rail, weakened a bit in the drive. SARAH'S MAN off the pace and the inside, swung out five wide for the drive, went evenly to the wire. SENOR SMILEY vied early off the inside, three wide into the bend, got out late turn when tiring. BUBBY BOLT made little impact from the two path. POINT GOLD off the pace, roused, four wide through the turn, failed to respond in the drive. NOAH'S TRAVELER off the pace outside, steadied midway on the turn while five wide, lacked a rally after recovering. BERTSGOLDENMISSILE last away, trailed throughout.
