COUNTRYBOYATHEART tucked inside soon after the start, saved ground first turn, began a steady advance after a half, challenged the leader while remaining inside past the furlong marker, edged clear. DOROTHY'S LUCK closest to the leader, collared that one turning for home, showed the way past the furlong marker while allowing the winner the inside, could not match strides with that foe in the waning strides. TIME FOR TROUBLE broke on top, soon got well clear while setting some quick splits, lasted for the show. SPEEDY CAT went evenly paced throughout, lacked a closing kick. POSSE COMITATUS was finished early, outrun. REMEMBER HOAGY slow to settle from the start, fell further and further back, distanced.
