BOWMAN'S MUSIC off the pace, fanned five wide when beginning to advance out of the turn, rallied down the middle of the strip to be clear at the end. STORMY M. T. L. showed the way early, replaced on the lead in the turn, squeezed through a tight opening into the stretch, regained the advantage but could not contain the winner late. JOE'S WITNESS off the early pace, roused in the three path late in the turn, moved out a bit for some room inside the furlong marker, along for the show. CORN DOG off a bit slow, moved up under restraint into a forward position into the turn, challenged late in that bend from between foes, weakened in the drive. FRIENDLY PATRIOT four wide through the turn when forwardly placed, bid into the stretch, faltered. MAN IN COMMAND forward early, vied up front through the turn three path, also gave way in the drive. RARE LUKEY forward early, began to tire from those efforts in the turn. TALKING DUKE off a bit slow, never a threat. ZARBS THUNDER BOY also a bit tardy to leave, outrun. CHIP'S BIGBOY broke out and slowly, fell far back, distanced.
