SWEET EUGEENA closest to the leader in the run up the backstretch, went after that foe turning for home, gained the advantage a furlong out, fully extended to prove best. PERTSHIRE got clear early, set the pace, responded when challenged midstretch by the winner, proved stubborn until the end. ST. PATSY forwardly placed along the inside, pulled hard onto the backstretch, continued to race within striking distance, moved out a bit after falling back nearing the furlong marker, slowly getting back to the top two late, missed the place. DOUBLE GRAN lacked speed, continued back the middle half, came three wide into the late, set down, displayed some belated interest while well outside at the wire. BRILLANT AND ROYAL within striking distance, three wide in the drive, lacked a winning kick late. STACEY LEE off a bit slow to be last away, raced well back, improved position a bit by passing some tiring foes. HUNG UP outrun early, in some traffic into the lane, steadied when lacking room a furlong out, came up empty after recovering. TANGO TEASE four wide through the first turn, lacked a rally. DYNASTIQUE tired outside.
