ZAVA JACK forwardly placed from the start, vied between foes and into the lane in the four path, confidently and narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, larger lead late, just lasted. CLASSIC LIL HOOVES asked for some run early but could not keep up, waited behind the first flight in the two path late in the turn, got clear in the drive, set down, split foes late and was going very well at the end. THE DIVINE TUNNEL off the early pace, advanced to vie five wide midway on the turn, continued on equal terms with the the winner midstretch, weakened a bit late, just held the show. RUBICUND narrowly set the pace for along the inside, also weakened a bit in the late going, missed the show. RARE LUKEY with the pace for a half, fell back from between foes turning for home, continued to weaken. BRAZOS EGO within striking distance in the early going, came up empty for the drive. MIDLAND MAN slow to begin, moved out, wide out of the turn, outrun.
