OLE'ELENA with the pace from the start, vied between rivals, kicked clear in the drive. COMALAGOLD vied up front four wide, proved no match for the winner. DIAMOND DERBY with the pace three wide and just outside the winner, held the show. SHIMMY DOLL sluggish early, displayed some late interest. ZIGNOR vied along the inside, gave way. LADY SABRINA vied six wide into the turn, lost considerable ground, evenly through the stretch. PROVIDENCE vied five wide into the turn, weakened. DIXIETOWNLADY was not a factor. MISS WOODVILLE outrun. BEYERS FORTUNE gave way suddenly in the drive, eased to the wire.
