MIZZEN MAZE broke alertly, set the pace, rated along into the far turn, called on for some run when straightened for home, proved best in the drive in a determined effort. PERFECT PEACE steadied along the inside when a bit tight leaving the first turn, fell back a bit, closer second turn while continuing inside, steadied again a furlong out when attempting to get in a bit while between foes, second best. MURRELL broke out, four wide through the first turn, stalked the pace outside, closest to the winner turning for home, weakened a bit late, best of the rest. DIXIE DOT RUN lacked speed, continued back while on the outside into the stretch, improved position a bit through traffic. SOLAR OBSERVATORY settled off the pace, moved closer on the outside late in the second turn, flattened out and lacked a further bid. LITTLE RED RALLY outrun early, saved some ground into the far turn, angled out with a quarter remaining, came up empty for the drive. GARRETT'S MONEYBAG was never a threat. CLUB prompted the early pace, began a steady retreat before a half.
