Footnotes

DYNAMIC TIME narrowly set the pace inside, turned back a pair of foes into the lane, strongly clear, steadied slight when drifting in a sixteenth out, held runner up comfortably safe late. SMITTY'S MOONSHINE closest to the two leaders along the inside, moved out, advanced and lodged a mild bid three wide turning for home, no match for the winner, remained clear for the place. LEESTOWNS FINALE raced in the second group while outside, finished up best of the rest. PRINCE OF APRIL dueled outside the winner for six furlongs, faltered in the drive. I'M INDY GOLD evenly paced behind the pace, between foes into the far turn, lacked a late kick in the drive. ARCTIC COMET off slowly, trailed for six furlongs, found best stride too late through and outside of rivals. CY'S HOPE saved ground early, moved out a bid into the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was never dangerous in the drive. BUCK'S REVENGE off pace, also lacked a kick in the drive. PERILOUS CROSSING raced back, was carried out five wide turning for home, failed to respond in the drive. CRESCENT CITY ZIP remained always back. HEART BRICK HOTEL moved up the rail to be a bit closer after a half, pinched back into the far turn, did not recover.
