SEFAPIANO JR. last away, unhurried in the early going, waited while saving ground in the second turn, got through inside, moved out for room nearing the furlong marker, roused, finished willingly under clever handling. ROCKITTOWN settled off the pace, advanced four wide late in the second turn, lost some ground into the lane, set down, also was going well at the end. DESSY set a moderate pace while in hand, garnered a slightly larger advantage into the far turn, continued to show the way into the lane, proved no match for the top two. TWILIGHT ROSS carried out while well off the pace into the first turn, continued back, five wide into the lane, staged mild rally. BLACK CROSS forwardly placed, boxed in, waited along the inside late in the final turn, came up empty for the final furlong when clear. SEA THE SOLDIER within striking distance much of the way, lacked a response in the drive. WALKONTHEBRITESIDE well back,. five wide late in the final turn, failed to muster much of a rally. HENRY'S TEDDYBEAR settled off the pace, in some

traffic in the second turn, weakened when the real running started turning for home. SOCIAL HEAT was racing well back when he carried TWILIGHT ROSS into the first turn, trailed, steadied behind horses turning for home, picked off a couple of tiring foes. DAWASMI pressured the pace for six furlongs and gave way. MANE MAN bit wide in the first turn, backed up through the stretch. ZARB'S GUNNER forward early, steadily faded.
