Fee must accompany the nomination. Regular nominations are due Saturday, August 25th at a fee of \$1,000, which shall accompany the nomination. \$2,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,500 to start. Supplementary nominations of \$20,000 are due Wednesday, September 5th (includes entry and starting fees). \$500,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 18% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to be paid sixth through ninth with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box on Wednesday, September 5, 2012 with the following preference formula applied: (1) Prelude winner (entry and starting fees will be waived). (2) Total money earned in Graded Stakes. (3) Total money earned. (Money earned shall be determined at time of entry). This race will not be divided. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The Owner, Trainer and Jockey of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed August 25, 2012 with 31 nominees.

Footnotes

BOURBON COURAGE last away, raced back and off the inside, launched a good move four wide through the second turn to reach contention, took over, shook clear under a right handed stick, drifted out when switched to a left handed whip while maintaining a comfortable advantage. FLY LEXIS FLY hopped slightly at the start, lacked speed, angled out to be five wide turning for home, set down for the drive and finished up willingly down the middle of the strip to be in time for the place. MASTER RICK raced in the second flight off the inside, advanced and challenged three wide late in the final turn, gained a narrow advantage turning for home, proved no match for the winner, nipped final strides for the place. ROUSING SERMON void of early foot, continued back, was six wide and outside the runner up exiting the final turn, displayed a moderate amount of late interest to improve position. TENSAS COLD FRONT off the pace and the inside, four wide through the first turn, continued mid pack and outside, four wide again late in the second bend, went evenly through the stretch in lacking a late kick. HERO OF ORDER pressured the leader off the inside, raced on equal terms with that one when confronted by others late in the final turn, offered little resistance, gave way. BLUESKIESRAINBOWS away in good order, took command before crossing the wire the first time, set a reasonable pace along the inside, gave way readily turning into the stretch. KEY DONATION settled off the pace along the inside, retreated. MR BLUEGRASS MUSIC unruly in the gate, gave way with a half mile remaining, distanced.
