STAKES Sunday Silence S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS.(INCLUDED \$150,000 FROM SLOT REVENUE). WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Non winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 4 lbs.; Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs.; maidens allowed 8 lbs. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting back to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest earnings. Different owners will have equal draw according to earnings. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, August 25, 2012 with 34 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

Footnotes

JAVA'S WAR bothered at the start, raced back early, moved closer toward the inside late backstretch, bided time under patient handling through the second turn, eased out to be three wide for the drive, outside bid a sixteenth out, proved narrowly best in a determined effort. BROWN ALMIGHTY forwardly placed inside, assumed command after SEQUOYAH WELLS carried the first flight out early in the second turn, rated when showing the way up the backstretch, responded when challenged second turn, shook clear when straightened for home, responded when the winner came alongside late, gave ground grudgingly to that rival, well clear of the rest. KAMCHATKA five wide into the first turn when the first group was carried out, stalked the pace on the outside up the backstretch, challenged four wide in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. TARMAC fell back to trail, continued to race well back far turn, swung out to be widest for the drive, finished up willingly while remaining well out in the course. MR. BANDINI'S BAND lacked speed, moved to within striking distance while four wide late in the final turn, lacked a further bid. SEQUOYAH WELLS broke on top, showed the way early, got out into the first turn carrying foes out with him, tracked the leader, attempted to get out again late in the second turn when beginning to weaken, continued to tire stretch. UNBRIDLED'S SCORE behind the pace first turn, four wide second turn, tired. I'M IN TO SHINE off the pace while saving ground, moved a bit closer while continuing inside in the second turn, hung in the drive. MR. MCCOY four wide into the first turn, gave way in the second turn. SIR PULPIT carried out into the first turn, continued to race forward up the backstretch, faded through the stretch.
