LADY J J behind the winner while toward the inside, moved to the outside of that rival in midstretch, missed while outfinished. BETWEEN US GIRLS raced outside, finished best of the rest. I'MA CHU CHU improved position slightly while not a threat. B. L.'S PRINCESS lacked a response in the drive while racing three wide. SPEND A WISH five wide late in the turn, no factor. MARYS AVIE outrun. BLACKHAWK'S DOUBLE fell back after the start and showed nothing. MISTY BROOKE gave way in the turn.
