DOLCE DIVA stalked the pace along the inside under patient handling, eased out a bit to be three wide turning for home for room, challenged soon after and drove well clear. MEDIEVAL JAZZ pressured the leader off the inside, put a head in front late in the second turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, proved no match for the winner late while remaining clear for the place. BLINKIT within striking distance, came four wide into the lane, went evenly to the wire. EAGLEIERE void of early foot, saved ground into the lane, moved out a bit, displayed some modest late interest. KISS FOR JULIE narrowly showed the way toward the inside, faltered when headed late in the second turn. CIEL CLASSIC fanned five wide turning for home when with the second flight, retreated down the stretch. PARIS PRIDE never menaced. STORM TEASER was finished early.
