Footnotes

COOL HAND VAL showed the way past the wire the first time, relinquished the advantage while off the inside first turn, pressed the issue in the run up the backstretch, took over midway on the second turn, held the runner up at bay late under steady handling. THEY CALL HIM EL well back off the early pace, made a good gain into the far turn, tried the winner from the outside into the lane, denied. MAURICEVILLE lacked speed, staged a steady, mild rally three wide, far clear of the others. HIGH ROAD took over along the inside first turn, showed the way for almost six furlongs and weakened. I'M GOOD TO GO completely devoid of early foot, picked off some tiring foes late through some traffic. CORREDOR CAT forwardly placed early, began a steady fade after a half. TALKIN MCCARTY tired outside. GET READY HATERS was never involved.
