DO THE TIGER back early, moved up the inside into a striking position midway on the turn, angled out three wide, bid into the lane, put a head in front when straightened for home and drew steadily clear. SCAMP AND A HALF forwardly placed, challenged midway in the turn off the inside, between foes into the lane, could not keep up with the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. LA ESTRELLITA lacked speed, staged a mild rally off the inside while not a threat to the top two. CARSON'S TWINKLE off the pace, carried out a bit to be four wide out of the turn, failed to respond when asked. W W RED SQUARE last away, trailed early, picked off some tiring foes while not a threat. SEFAS WASP narrowly set the pace for a half along the inside, gave way. BURLETTA showed early foot outside, taken further outside, gingerly ridden from the three furlong marker in. STORMY DELIGHT staged a steady retreat.
