TIZ A SCHOLAR void of early foot, swung out five wide turning for home, engaged the leaders with less than a furlong remaining, edged clear. ROCK HARD also unhurried early, ranged up to challenge four wide late in the final turn, took over, showed the way past the furlong marker, could not contain the winner, held the place. LITTLE PINKIE off the pace, moved up closer behind a wall of horses exiting the final turn, clipped heels, broke stride, fell back, switched to the outside after recovering, finished up willingly to be getting to the runner up. MARGOS WALKER settled in the second flight off he inside early, advanced and challenged three wide midway on the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. IMA CHAMPALI alternated for the lead closet to the inside, faltered in the drive. RODEO RACER with the early pace, dueled off the inside for six furlongs, also gave way in the drive.
