Footnotes

FINE TROUBLEMAKER with the pace along the inside, shook clear when straightened, held the 4runner up safe late. GOODIFITGOES shuffled back a bit before a quarter, three wide and back through the turn, roused for the drive, late run through traffic to be closing the gap late. PRIZED TOP CAT forwardly placed outside, four wide through the turn, continued outside, not enough for the place. SHARIR forwardly placed early between foes, fell back a bit into the turn, came up empty. FASEAUX toward the front in the early going, shuffled back into the turn, inside the runner up into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. TOOTHPICKSANDWATER moved up to vie for the early advantage, weakened in the drive. HIT THAT STRIKE saved ground throughout, steadied in a bit tight turning for home, continued inside, lacked a significant late response. WOODMAN'S REVENGE made little impact while three wide. CAFE SKITDADDEL raced mid pace, steadied into the turn, fell back, no threat. TRUETT'S REBEL off slowly, remained back throughout. LUCKYLEESTOWN within striking distance, five wide through the turn, gave way in the drive.
