FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. (Includes \$150,000 from Slot Revenue). WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Non winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 4 lbs.; Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs.; maidens allowed 8 lbs. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting back to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest earnings in 2011. Different owners will have equal draw according to preference. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, August 27, 2011 with 64 nonimees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

Footnotes

GUNG HO broke in, brushed, allowed the pace to go early, continued in mid pack through the second turn, some traffic into lane, steered to the outside nearing the furlong marker, finished with good late energy to be in time. TOP CAT BOOGIE broke well, showed the way early, continued to set the back while rating up the backstretch, shook clear of the other speed turning for home, long lead, could not contain the winner. PRYCE'S POSSE unseated rider and ran off for three furlongs prior to the start, broke in good order, chased the runner up most of the way, could not match that rival or the winner in the drive, held the show. TEQUILA FACTOR a bit rank into the first turn and off the inside, continued within striking distance, lacked a winning response in the drive and finished up evenly. EASTON JACK brushed at the start, lacked speed, four wide out of the final turn, lodged a mild bid late to improve position.

INDIAN ASSAULT went evenly while racing off the inside. E VALENTINO bothered slightly at the start, raced back off the pace, in a bit tight while between foes turning for home, lacked a serious late kick. JOE'S NO SAINT void of early foot after being the last to leave, continued to trail second turn, improved position through traffic while not a serious threat. NOBLE ALEX bothered at the start, raced back, angled out to be five wide out of the final turn, made little impact through the stretch. DOUBLE BIRDIE stalked the pace from along the inside for six furlongs then gave way in the drive. WHISKEY DOUBLE steadily faded. ONE BRAVO settled off the pace, had little left for the drive.
