STORMY SCRAPPER away well, cleared to the inside, showed the way through the turn, shrugged off the other speed turning for home and drew clear. HOUSE OF STARS lacked speed, rallied from between foes turning for home, finished up willingly for the place. LA LOUETTA pressured the pace, vied between foes late in the turn, gave way late to lose the place. EL STORM moved up outside, lodged a brief bid in the four path late in the turn, also weakened in the late going. FIESTY PATSY lacked speed toward the inside, was never dangerous. LEESTOWN GIRL off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, managed little in the way of a rally. LAVENDER FIELDS forwardly placed in the early going behind the first flight, retreated. AMEN SPIRIT off slowly, trailed most of the way. KREWE AT WALLO'S no speed, five wide late in the turn, tired.
