BRASSY WELLS broke sharp, moved right to the rail, rated kindly while getting clear in the first turn, set a moderate pace and last under steady handling late. CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN, last away, was allowed to settle, made a steady advance outside and was getting to the winner late. BOSQUE COUNTY stalked the winner, went after that one late in the second turn then faltered in the drive. NEDLOG lacked early foot, was roused in the second turn, came on the outside into the stretch, drifted and went evenly late. FRANKLY CLASSIC moved closer early in the second turn then flattened out in the drive. MT. RENE raced forwardly and outside early and was finished after a half. SOME ACTOR showed little and remained back throughout. LIGHTENING BALL gave way after four furlongs.
