GUSTO NUEVO broke on top, cleared to the inside before a half, headed second turn, battled back in game fashion the final sixteenth while remaining inside. PURE ROCK off the early pace, lodged a middle move to take over before the six furlong marker, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, outfinished. WAJIR ON ME pinched start, began a steady gain after a half toward the inside, continued to improve to finish best of the rest while not a threat to the top two. QUIEN JOSE prompted the pace for five furlongs and had little left. CACHUMA'S LIL MAN tired from early efforts. BIG YARD BIRD pinched at the start, not a factor. DELTA COMMAND was never involved. PILGRIM GEORGE within striking distance for a half, stopped and finished far back.
