ZARB'S CHAMPION allowed the pace to go early, continued under patient handling backstretch, advanced while saving ground into the lane, rail bid a furlong out, drew out. TRULAKE sprinted out to a clear lead into the first turn, extended that advantage onto the backstretch, rated, allowed the winner the rail with a furlong to run, no match for that one, remained clear for the place. PROMISETOMAKE IT raced closest to the runner up, could do little with that foe or the winner in the drive, finished up best of the rest. MONKEY HANDS turned in an even effort while racing off the inside. WHEN SECONDS COUNT was never dangerous from the two path. MIKE'S COZZENE raced within striking distance outside, continued to stalk through the second turn, gave way in the drive. LITTLEBITTYRED raced back off the pace past the wire the first time, carried to outside rail, roughed between foes early first turn, fell well back. SAIL ON CAPOTE lacked early foot, also carried to the outside rail into the first turn to lose all chance. CANE RIVER bore out badly into the first turn carrying two rivals to the outside rail, pulled up, walked off.
