HIGH CASCADE outrun early while inside, moved out early in the turn, rallied on the outside into the stretch, took over just inside the furlong marker, edged clear. THREE JACK alternated for the lead off the inside and proved stubborn until the final strides. PISTOL AVENUE last away, far back for three furlongs, found best stride too late down the middle of the strip. IT'S A BOY within striking distance throughout, lacked a closing kick caught for show. CHOP CHOP raced back off the pace, roused three wide turning for home, staged a mild close. MIKE 'N DOC went evenly through the stretch. THIS WON dueled closest to the inside, gave way late while continuing inside. RAIL ROSE staged a steady retreat.
