JOHN LOUIS' PENNY away in good order, set the pace along the inside, turned back a bid turning for home, drove well clear. BUBBA PRINCESS settled off the pace while well off the inside, advanced and tried the winner from the outside in the second turn, proved no match in the drive, narrowly saved the place. GORUM broke on top, pressed the winner along the inside early, fell back but remained within striking distance the middle half, continued along the inside for the drive, outkicked for the place. ANGELS AROUND US pressured the pace off the inside, had little left for the stretch run. TUNNELFORMONEY rated off the pace and the inside, lacked a response in the drive. NO SHRINKINGVIOLET failed to menace while racing off the inside, moved out to be five wide late in the final turn, remained back. LUCKY VOW rank at the start to fall back immediately, far back when struck right handed with just off a half mile remaining, ducked in as a result, bounced off the rail, remained far back, distanced.
