### Footnotes

TRUE FLAT unhurried for six furlongs along the inside, angled out to be four wide when moving to challenge exiting the final turn, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker, held late under firm handling. SWAY SPLENDID bothered at the start, raced back, advanced in traffic out of the final turn, continued in traffic nearing the furlong marker, finished willingly when clear. LAST MUSIC broke out, bothered outer foes, lacked speed, shuffled back in some tight quarters midway on the final turn, continued to be surrounded into the straight, split foes, clear late for the show. WINDY LOU TOO void of speed after breaking a bit slow, saved ground, altered course to the outside for room midstretch, split foes, also improved significantly late. MOONSHINE BEND narrowly showed the way after breaking on top, weakened along the inside. PETIONVILLE RIDGE steadied onto the backstretch when near the back, fanned six wide into the lane, went evenly the final furlong. THE RED GUY within striking distance, raced in traffic while along the rail late in the second turn, came up empty when clear for the drive. SHOW UP JONES forwardly placed early after being four wide into the first turn, tired. HOLMYBEER WACHTHIS vied up front while racing off the inside, gave way. SPEED ROCKET six wide into the first turn, moved up to vie three wide up the backstretch, faltered. SUNDAY'S SUN bothered at the start, raced back early, advanced, five wide turning for home, gave way.
