WAJIR ON ME unhurried early, began to advance three furlongs outside, widest in the drive, just up. SLEEPY HOLLOW stalked the two leaders, challenged three wide nearing the furlong marker, nipped at the wire. HUMBLE SMARTY moved up to duel after a quarter off the inside, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, could not last. JERRY THE GENIUS was not a serious threat. PUTITBACKMICK cleared early, dueled middle half, faltered in the drive. AGERE last away, was not involved. THE TWO YOUTHS steadily faded.
