DOC STORM CAT with the pace from the start outside, vied four wide into and through the turn, shook clear entering the stretch, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire under steady pressure. ONE RANGER fell back a bit in the early going to be in the second flight into the turn, advanced, no match for the winner, proved game for the place. FATHERS BAD BOY narrowly showed the way early from between rivals, also proved no match for the winner in the drive, outfinished for the place while inside the runner up. KANAI off the pace and the inside, raced three wide through the turn, improved position. FRIENDLY FALCON forwardly placed early, fell back a bit in the turn, three wide out of the bend, went evenly to the wire. GROOVY DREAM off a bit slow, raced back, steered out to be five wide into the lane, improved position by passing mostly tiring rivals. WIRED SHARP flashed brief speed along the inside, began to fade before a half. KATS AMERICAN STAR off slowly, trailed, was seven wide out of the turn, passed tiring foes down the middle of the strip. COLTON COUNTDOWN off the pace toward the inside, had nothing for the drive. OUR DIVA FACTOR gave way after a half. FAN THE FIRE off slowly,

was never involved while wide. RISKY TIMBER gave way while five wide.
