Footnotes

VALID PROMISE stalked the early pace while three wide, moved up to challenge three wide late in the turn, drew out steadily through the lane while not being asked for best. ROAD TO LOVE forced the early pace, vied between foes out of the turn, proved no match for the winner in the drive, held sway for place. POWERFUL IMPACT back off the early pace, staged a mild rally off the inside to earn the show. POLE E CAT void of speed, came four wide out of the turn, improved position while too late, remained well out in the strip. KENNETT MO went evenly paced throughout. SHERYAR BUCK four wide and behind the first group out of the turn, failed to fire. BE LIKE JESUS steadied exiting the chute when prominent, narrowly set the pace along the inside, gave way in the drive. POSSE COMITATUS lacked speed, six wide exiting the turn, remained back. STEPHEN PARTEE within striking distance, also was six wide out of the turn, backed up through the stretch. DUCKY'S IDEA was not a threat. KINGS PRINCE also remained always back. CHORAL DUET was finished early.
