Footnotes

MIZZEN'S WAKE prompted the pace, engaged the leader for the drive from the outside, drifted out, fully extended to prove best. SNOOK broke on top, cleared to the inside, set the pace while in hand, continued to show the way past the furlong marker when engaged by the winner, proved stubborn to the end. MARION PONDEROSA lacked speed, raced in some traffic toward the inside into and through the far turn, split foes for the drive, finished well clear of the others. WAR REGENT last to leave, void of speed for six furlongs, steered to the outside for the drive and staged a mild rally. RICKY BOBBY within striking distance, came up empty when asked for the drive. ROCKITTOWN went evenly in also lacking a late bid. HEATH'S SHOW had little left for the drive. LOTTO CAT was never involved. ASIAN CAT tired after a half.
