DUSTY TUNNEL rated off the pace, ranged up in hand well out in the strip through the second turn, vied into the stretch, edged away late. CAT ANTE with the pace, held a narrow advantage into the second turn, dueled inside the winner into the stretch, second best. RED HAWKEYE evenly paced inside, continued to ride the rail through the stretch, best of the rest. FOOLS DAY moved a bit closer in the second turn, hung in the drive. LEAD WOLF with the pace toward the inside, gave way. TUMBLE 'N NELSON trailed, distanced.
