WIFE FOR LIFE, unhurried early, began to move in the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and strongly drew clear under a moderate hand ride. CROOK'S ANGEL, a bit wide in the first run, lodged a three wide bid three furlongs out, could not match strides with the winner while prevailing for the place. DUE TO WIN, four wide through both turns, finished best of the others. AMY MAE, a forward factor toward the inside, had little left late. ANGEL'S TEARLET raced within striking distance while saving ground, raced in a bit tight in the second turn and came up empty for the drive. FULLASATICK set or forced the pace off the rail and gave way badly in the drive.
