TIME TO BUY set a comfortable pace, enough left to hold sway at the end. G. I. JANA within striking distance, could do little with the winner in the late going despite firm handling. CATERETTE unhurried early, advanced in traffic late in the second turn, also failed to make up much ground, finished best to the rest. MS. DOWDEN patient handling, shuffled back while still in hand, managed only a modest late gain. LACE CASTELLI lacked a late kick. MERTZ'S LIL NELSON four wide in the first turn, weakened after a half. KOSTROMA PASS last away, five wide into the stretch, no rally. NEVER HIGH forwardly placed for six furlongs, gave way in the drive.
