### Footnotes

LIVEALITTLEBIT stalked the early pace outside, moved closer four wide turn, set down when straightened for home, finished full of run to win going away. CARSON'S TWINKLE with the pace off the inside, garnered a larger advantage in the stretch, proved no match for the winner, held sway for the place. GITTIIUPGO settled off the pace, saved some ground through the second turn, steered out for room turning for home, up for the show. SWEET TEXAS STAR within striking distance, continued one paced, lacked a late kick. ISLAND BLUFF chased the early leader, moved up to contest the issue before a half, between foes second turn, weakened in the drive. SHE'SAMARK lacked speed, came four wide out of the final turn, lacked the necessary closing response to be a factor. QUEEN OF PIZAZZ last to leave, trailed, passed tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. STILL QUICK was never a factor. SMOOTH SEA was also always outrun. NORTHERN WINN away best of all, set or forced the pace for six furlongs along the inside and stopped.
