TOUGH ISSIE steadied slightly at the start, raced back, moved up a bit closer along the inside and in traffic late backstretch, in tight three furlongs out, continued inside, waited late in the second turn, moved out for room in the drive, finished with good determination late to prove best. DIVINE LORRETTA five wide down to four through the first turn, continued outside, raced four out to five wide in the second turn to lose some ground roused for the drive, was also going well at the end while remaining well out in the course.. FEEL THE GREED pressed the issue early, vied up front the middle half mile, garnered a larger advantage when straightened for home, could not late. GALLOP IN THE PARK within striking distance, bit closer while between foes and in traffic second turn, lacked a closing punch in the drive. TORTUGA TOWN off a step slow, trailed in lacking speed, saved ground second turn, steadied when lacking room entering the stretch, improved position by showing some late interest when clear. BARZAK void of speed, raced three wide out of the final turn, improved position the final furlong while not a serious threat. A RUNNIN POP well back off the pace, moved to the outside for the drive, lacked a late kick. DARBY SAYS SEE YA saved ground, tired. SKIPAWAYWITHPAT a pace factor along the inside until a furlong remained, fell apart late. MUCHO MARY forwardly placed for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. BAYOU ROAD was finished after a half.
