FORUM RULES away in good order, pressed the leader into the turn, challenged soon after, long drive, proved best. TIZZY BOY got clear up front late backstretch, vied through the turn, stretch duel, outfinished, well clear of the others. ANTE UP PETE moved closer up the inside into the turn, steadied in traffic soon after, angled out for the drive, could do little with the top two. DUSTY TUNNEL forwardly placed, three wide bid late in the turn, was fading a bit when bothered upper stretch, continued to weaken. BADA IN NEVADA raced four wide through the turn, had little left for the drive. ANIMPERIAL WIN back early, improved position four wide through the turn, went evenly in the drive. HE'S TRICKY was not a serious threat. ASSAULT COMMANDER lacked a rally. STAR WILL SHINE tired from early efforts. TAMAAKAJA last away, trailed, finished well back.
