(2) Total money earned in Graded Stakes. (3) Total money earned. (Money earned shall be determined at time of entry). This race will not be divided. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The Owner, Trainer and Jockey of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, September 5, 2009 with 30 nominees.

Footnotes

REGAL RANSOM broke on top, rated kindly through some soft fractions the first three quarters, shrugged off a mild bid by SOUL WARRIOR midway on the final turn when called on for some run, shook well clear when straightened for home, wrapped up late to win ridden out. BLAME settled off the pace and the inside, moved a bit closer three wide in the second turn, fell back off the winner when that one was asked turning for home, set down, came in slightly nearing the furlong marker, finished well and while he closed the gap late, the winner had already wrapped up. MASSONE lacked speed, moved a bit closer while saving some ground into the second turn, roused soon after, slight brush nearing the furlong marker, proved no match for the top two. SOUL WARRIOR closest to the winner the first six furlongs, tried that one with a mild bid late in the final turn, could not keep up into the stretch, was beginning to weaken when in tight nearing the furlong marker, continued to tire. RED LEAD within striking distance for five furlongs, raced off the inside, had little left for the drive. UNO MAS last to leave, trailed off the inside, made little impact the final three furlongs. ELECTRIC ALPHABET three wide and off the pace in the first turn, began to weaken after five furlongs.
