WILLIAM'S KITTEN sluggish in the early going, fanned six wide into the stretch, finished up full of run down the middle of the strip, won ridden out. PERFECT LOU settled off the pace, raced in some traffic into the lane, brushed, drifted in past the furlong marker, no match for the winner, held sway for the place. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. FUDGE TRUFFLE within striking distance along the inside, continued along the rail into and through upper stretch, tight, bothered a furlong out, moved out and was up for the show. WHY NOT BE PERFECT got clear before a quarter, continued to set the pace, shook briefly clear when straightened for home, faltered and could not last. KING OF THE BAYOU chased the leader early, continued to forced the issue second turn while off the inside, began to weaken midstretch, drifted out, brushed, bothered by the runner up when that one drifted in soon after, continued to fade. PRINCE EDDINGTON three wide when off the pace, in some traffic turning for home, failed to rally. JOEY'S MIZZEN MAST lacked speed, five wide turning for home, remained back.
