CHIEF JAY broke alertly, vied up front along the inside, shook free, kept to task. COREY'S RED BOY away in good order, fell back outside, carried out six wide into the stretch, finished willingly widest of all to be second best. GENEROUS MAN moved up to vie three wide, had nothing for the winner in the drive, weakened late, held the show. MACHO TIME evenly paced, did not have enough for the show. LAC VALENTINE lacked early speed, came five wide out of the turn, improved position a bit while not a serious threat. RUBICUND with the pace four wide through the turn, faltered in the drive. SOUTHERN STYLE moved up just before a quarter to contest the pace while between foes, gave way in the drive. LOUISIANA LIGHTNIN had little left for the drive. NOOTKA SOUND was through early. GO RED GO trailed.
