GYPSY POLE E TELL broke on top, set or forced the pace off the inside, shook clear just inside the furlong marker, held the runner up safe late under firm handling. DAISY BOY last to leave, lacked speed, steered out to be five wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the center of the strip to be in time for the place, getting to winner as well. BULLY BOY vied up front inside the winner, could not keep up with that rival the final furlong, caught in the final strides for the place. THREE LEGGED off the pace while saving ground, moved out nearing the furlong marker to bother WHO DAT GEAUX, finished up evenly. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF WHO DAT GEAUX AGAINST THREE LEGGED FOR INTERFERENCE IN MIDSTRETCH, THREE LEGGED WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH. PRIME CUVEE bumped at the start, failed to threaten off the inside. WHO DAT GEAUX fractious prior to the start, reluctant to load, raced in mid pack while outside, four wide turning for home, was going evenly in midstretch when bothered by THREE LEGGED, weakened. CHICOLA showed little. CLINEY broke out, bumped PRIME CUVEE, recovered to race forwardly early, gave way in the drive.
