Footnotes

ESSENCE OF DUBAI broke well, showed the way past the wire the first time off the inside, got out slightly into the first turn, continued to set a modest pace in the run up the backstretch, larger lead into the stretch, increased advantage under steady handling. WALK IN THE SNOW dueled inside the winner into the first turn, pressured that one while continuing to save ground, could not match strides in the drive while holding the place. A. P. FIVE HUNDRED within striking distance, moved closer three wide in the second turn, failed to manage any further gain and finished evenly. THE JUDGE SEZ WHO allowed to settle off the pace and the inside, came four wide out of the final turn, modest late gain. THUNDER DAYS lacked speed while off the rail, went evenly through the stretch. PRIVATE EMBLEM behind the pace, asked second turn, came up empty for the drive. CHOP CHOP four wide in the first turn, steadily faded, distanced in the stretch after losing contact with the field. GLITZI'S CLASSIC crowded back at the start, fell far back, distanced.
