WARGAMER forwardly placed early outside, fell back early turn, roused four wide into the stretch, finished willingly to be in time. DEVILISHLY CLEVER with the pace while between foes, continued to vie through and exiting the turn, shook clear inside the furlong grounds, could not contain the winner. SPOTSBACK void of early foot, four wide rally out of the turn, along for the show. THE ARKANSAN vied up front while three wide, continued to contest the issue past the furlong marker, weakened in the late going. MORLUC'S SECRET broke with the field, improved inside of traffic through the turn, failed to sustain that advance in the drive. PAPA ZACK narrowly set the pace along the inside for a half, faltered. OL' BOB within striking distance early, tired from those efforts. PRINCE DUSTY was finished early. PICK MY KID steadied at the start, remained always back. REINFORCE veered in just after the start, unseated rider.
